CONTEXT TO TRUSTEE REMUNERATION RESOLUTION

In 2023, MIST commissioned the Institute of Directors (IoD) to undertake an independent review of board fees to ensure fair, transparent, and market-aligned remuneration.

The IoD's findings were based on PSGE and Māori sector benchmarks and recognised MIST's complex Treaty settlement responsibilities and high governance workload.

Summary of IoD Findings

Workload: Trustees 256 hours/year; Chair 470 hours/year (well above market medians).

Benchmarks: Trustees \$17,000 to \$20,000; Chair \$34,000 to \$40,000 (Chair premium ≈ ×2).

Recommendation for MIST: \$20,000 per Trustee and \$40,000 for the Chair (fixed annual).

Good practice: Review fees every 1–3 years and disclose remuneration openly in annual reports.

The proposed remuneration resolution aligns with this independent advice and reflects the scale and responsibilities of MIST as the Moriori Post-Settlement Governance Entity.
